

K4 Four-Year Old Kindergarten

(Students must be 4 years old by September 1 of the year they are starting.)

Language Arts

Phonics and Reading

- Recognition of name, sound, and picture of long and short vowels and consonants
- Sounding of blends and one- and two-vowel words
- Reading of sentences and stories with one- and two vowel words

Cursive Writing

- Formation of letters, blends, and words
- Writing of first name

Poetry

- Twenty-eight poems and finger plays committed to memory

Language

- Language of development, and listening skills that include color words, shapes, animals, transportation, countries, community helpers, health, safety, manners, science

Numbers

- Number recognition and counting 1-100
- Number concepts 1-20
- Numbers before and after 1-20
- Numbers largest and smallest 1-20
- Addition facts 1+1 to 1+9

Bible

- Lessons such as Creation, Noah, Boy Samuel, Daniel, Boyhood of Jesus, Zacchaeus, Good Samaritan (includes memory verses and hymns/choruses)
