This is a self-managed application. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all steps in the application process are completed. Your application will be considered for admission upon the receipt of all applicable forms listed in Step 1.

Step 1 - Submit Forms

Completed Application for Admission, along with a \$150 nonrefundable application fee.

Completed Request for Testing, along with a \$50.00 nonrefundable testing fee.

Checks should be made payable to Humble Christian School.

Admissions Required Supplemental Forms – Recommendations and reference forms must be mailed directly to Humble Christian School.

Step 2 – Testing

Applicants will be contacted by a staff member of Humble Christian School to schedule testing. Testing is required for grades K-5 through 12.

Step 3 - Interview

Applicants will be contacted by a staff member of Humble Christian School when the application, pastor's recommendation and the testing has been completed.

Step 4 - Admissions Committee Review

Following the interview, student applications will be presented to the Admissions Committee for review. Parents will be notified of the committee's decision.
