

# Admissions Policies and Process

## Admissions Policies

The Administration of Humble Christian School evaluates applicants on the following: application information, personal recommendations from pastors; academic achievement including transcripts and standardized testing; conduct and character that exemplify good citizenship; and a family dedication to Christian education. In light of these evaluations, it is specifically important that the student show aptitude to succeed in a rigorous academic environment; that the family be active in a local church; that at least one parent/guardian be a born-again believer in Christ; and that the student's conduct record be positive and show no suspension from school.

In order to start K4, a child must be 4 years old by August 1. In order to start Kindergarten, a child must be 5 years old by August 1. In order to start 1<sup>st</sup> grade, a child must be 6 years old by August 1. No exceptions. All applicants must be able to care for restroom needs independently.

## Admissions Process

This is a self-managed application. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all steps in the application process are completed. Your application will not be considered for admission until the receipt of all applicable forms listed in Step 1.

### Step 1 - Submit Forms

**Completed Application for Admission**, along with a \$300 nonrefundable application fee.

**Completed Request for Testing**, along with a \$75.00 nonrefundable testing fee.

Checks should be made payable to Humble Christian School.

**Completed Student Registration Forms**, including copies of birth certificate, social security card and immunization records.

### Step 2 – Testing

Applicants will be contacted by a staff member of Humble Christian School to schedule testing. Testing is required for all grades K4 through 12<sup>th</sup>, unless applicant is able to provide approved standardized test scores taken within the past year.

### Step 3 – Interview

After testing has been completed, applicant will be contacted to set up an interview. During interview, Administrator will go over test results and application. You will be informed of acceptance status at end of interview.
